# *Children who are 8 or 10 years old needed for a research study on learning at the MGH-Institute of Health Professions*

## **WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?**

This is a longitudinal study that follows children over a period of 3 consecutive years. The goal of this study is to improve understanding of learning in children.

## **WHY SHOULD MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?**

- Help us learn about kids' brains and how they learn
- Make a difference in research about learning development
- Your child will participate in fun activities and will be able to see his/her brainwaves.

## **WHAT IS INVOLVED?**

- One visit to our lab at the MGH-IHP in the Charlestown Navy Yard every year for three years
- Lab visits are scheduled on weekdays and weekends.
- A visit takes about 2.5 hours.
- A quick follow up test on a home computer/iPad/mobile phone a day after the visit.
- Fun word learning and sorting computer games
- A few memory tests
- Lab visits include safe and noninvasive EEG recording

## **WILL MY CHILD BE PAID?**

- Yes! Pay is \$60 per year. A prize is given at the end of each lab visit. We pay for parking.

## **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?**

- Children who are, or soon turning 8 or 10 years
- Are English speaking
- Have no history of head injury, concussions, seizures, developmental/language/learning/Attention disorders, or other neurological deficits.
